ELIGIBILITY: The West Coast Pony Finals are open to any Small, Medium, or Large Pony.

ROUND 1: All ponies will jump one round at their respective heights, and receive a numerical score from the judge(s). Large Ponies will jump first in Round 1, followed by Medium Ponies and then Small Ponies. The computer will draw the order of go for each section.

ROUND 2: All ponies from each height section from Round 1 with a score that is higher than 60, will return for Round 2. Their first round scores will be carried forward, and the order of go within each section will be low score to high score. Small Ponies will jump first followed by Medium Ponies and then Large Ponies. The second round score will be averaged with the first round score to determine final placing.

TIES: In case of ties for first place in any section or for Grand Champion or Grand Reserve Champion, the judges will confer and determine relative placing of those ties.

SPECIAL PRIZES: All riders will receive West Coast Pony Finals gifts as determined by the show committee.

Awards will be given in each height section as follows:

\$1,000 divided - \$300, \$240, \$180, \$120, \$90, \$70 -

Embroidered Coolers to the top two and ribbons thru 10th. Other special awards to be determined by the show committee.

Grand Champion (the pony with the highest overall score from the two rounds regardless of section)

Name engraved on Perpetual Trophy - Keepsake Trophy - Championship Ribbon - Special Award

Reserve Grand Champion (the pony with the second highest overall score from the rounds regardless of section)

Entry Fee - \$100

Eligibility: Open to any Small, Medium, or Large Pony Registered with the USHJA.

Fence Height: 1.00M (3'3") with spreads to 1.10m (3'7")

Scoring: To be scored under Table II, Section 2a - Time First Jump Off. The first round and first jump off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the event of equality of faults after the first round, there will be one jump-off for first place only in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults.

Order Of Go: The jumping order will be computer generated.

Awards: \$1,000 in prize money divided: \$300, \$240, \$180, \$120, \$90, \$70; embroidered coolers to Champion and Reserve; ribbons to 1st through 10th place; other special awards as determined by the show committee.
